Conditions	
Reciprocal Rights	TASC has reciprocal rights with Desert Alpine Club and Aorangi Ski Club, where our members can stay in their huts at our Club's member's rate. Members of the Taupo Ski Club can use the hut at TASC member rates. Reciprocal rights are not applicable for summer use
Ski Season Weekend Booking	During Ski season all weekend users must pay minimum of 2 nights (Friday & Saturday or Saturday & Sunday)
Booking Deposits	Large groups (10 or more) must make a 50% deposit to secure booking during the ski season
Payment terms	All bookings must be paid in full before the visit, unless alternative arrangements have been made with the booking officer or treasure
Minimum Number	Minimum Lodge booking for weekends is 6 people for 2 nights (Friday and Saturday). This number is set for safety and economic reasons. There is no minimum for summer use
Lodge Officer	All lodge booking must have a registered lodge officer with the group. The club can provide one if required. If the lodge officer is part of the booked party, then they must pay hut fees. If the club provides the lodge officer, then there are no fees for the lodge officer. The Lodge officer has the first option of using the warden's room if it is unoccupied
Work Parties	No fees for participants in work parties. Work parties are self catering unless arranged in advance when a food levy may be charged
Ticket Office operating	If the Ticket Office is operating during the ski season, then nobody is to sleep on the benches in the ticket office or use it afterhours
Cancellation	Cancellations with less than 7 days notice before booked dates will incur a cancellation fee of \$10 per person per night. Refund of lodge fees deposits received will be less cancellation fee. Cancellations less than 2 days will only be refunded, either in part or in full, only at the discretion of club's committee. Member cancellation benefit upto 4 days prior or at discription of booking officer.
Student/Children	All Student or Child guests must be under the care and control of a parent or an appropriate senior member of the group throughout their stay. This care ratio is limited to 4 students/children per adult
Infants	Infants are expected to share a bunk with an adult, or bring their own cot.
Members Room	The members room is to remain reserved for members only until Wednesday night, when it becomes available for non members

Booking Transfer

Bookings are not transferable

Definitions	
Ski Season	This is defined as the period that the "Skifield Tow Rope is out" or when the café is open
Departure and Arrival times	The hut must be clear by 4:00pm (preferable 3:00pm). The Hut (Bunk space) is not available to any arriving party prior to 4:00pm
Cooking Arrangements	Groups of 8 or more must cook communally
Catering covers:	Weekend : Super Friday Night, Breakfasts & Lunches Saturday & Sunday, Saturday Evening Meal, Tea/Coffee etc
	Weekday: All meals, but not breakfast on day of arrival, nor dinner of day of departure

- v. "Ski & Stay" packages are payable at the Tukino Skifield ticketing desk in the café
